



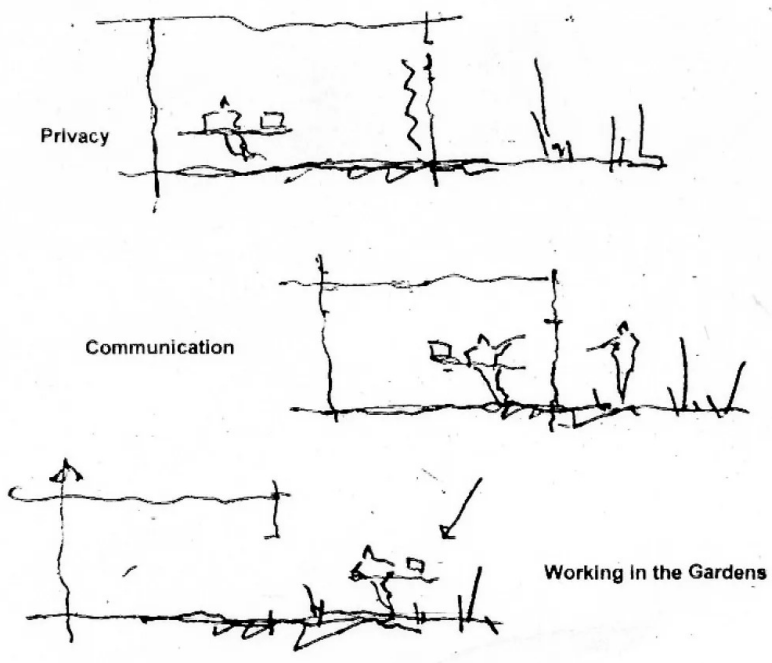
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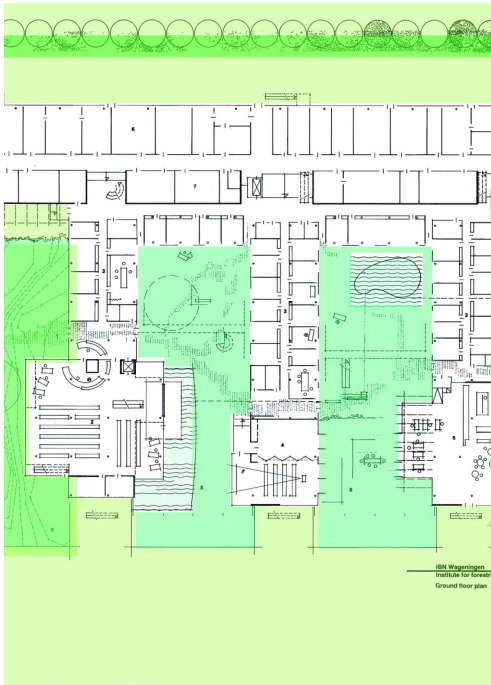
1994–1998

The laboratory and administration building, now called Lumen, is a mid-1990s pilot project for ecologically sound building in Europe. Located amid what was once an overfertilized agricultural area north of the university city of Wageningen, the Netherlands, the design was realized within a standard budget, demonstrating that sustainable strategies do not imply major investments. The project provided for a maximum reduction of carbon dioxide emissions.

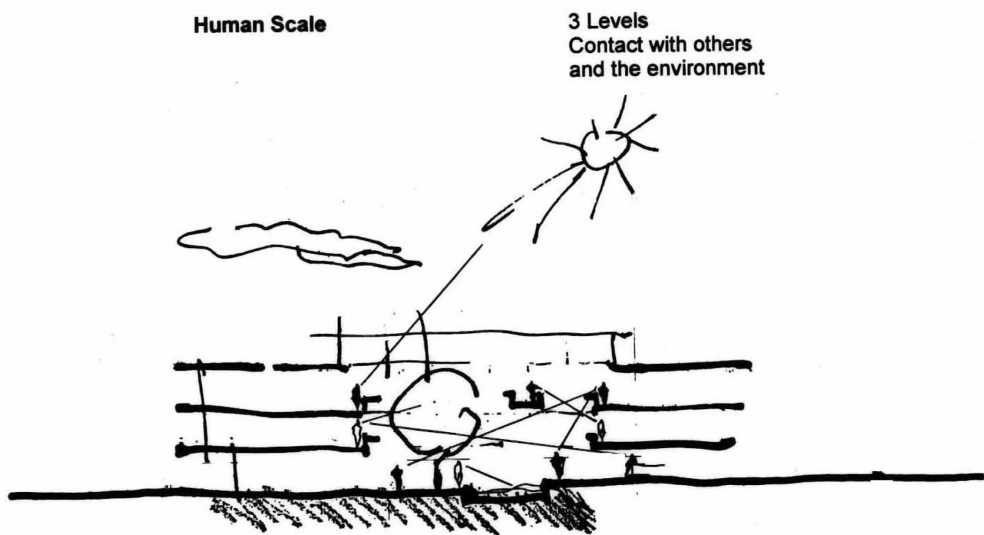
