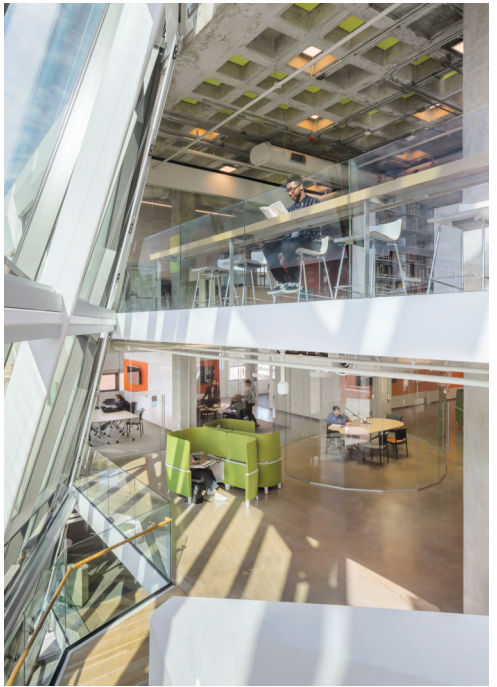
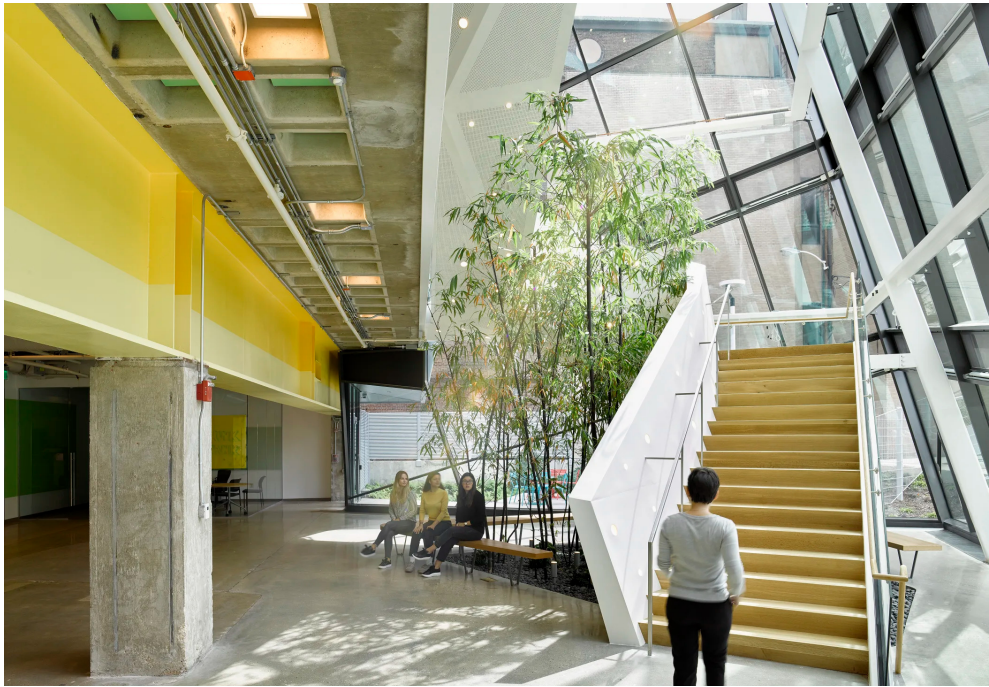
2014–2018
